The Hatley website has continued to provide the Parish with timely information about Parish Council and local matters (agendas and minutes of meetings, progress of Superfast broadband, public consultations, planning applications, Hatley Village Association events, St Denis' and Hatley St George church, road closures etc.)

As always, thanks are due to our webmaster Peter Mann for his continued enthusiasm at keeping the site updated and lively, on a voluntary basis. Thanks also to everyone who has contributed photographs of village events and other material to the website.

A website survey was conducted in May 2016. A summary of the replies from the 42 households who kindly took the trouble to complete the form are on the Hatley website. The survey has given a good indication of the most used and valued information on the site and provided ideas on other things we could add. Many survey responses complimented Peter Mann for his hard work.

Hatley Parish Council will shortly be applying to NALC's Transparency Fund for £500 funding towards the design of a new website which will be directly accessible to the Parish Clerk and Parish Councillors and will be suitable for use on all types of devices which connect to the internet. This will alleviate the pressure from Peter who currently runs the site single-handedly. The Parish Council has pledged £500 towards the design costs. The new site design will accommodate wishes expressed in the website survey as far as possible.
