From Hilary:

I hope there won't be too many more Newsletters which are bulletins on Norman's health! He again sends love and gratitude for all your good wishes as this week has included a trip to Addenbrooke's A&E recommended by the local surgery for matters not directly to do with his knee operation. The problem had not seemed urgent nor was it expected to require admission in the first place but, at time of writing, Norman is still there. He is in good spirits and awaiting more tests. We hope that by the time you read this he will be home - thank you for prayers and support - the pastoral network will be kept informed.

At the time of writing, we can similarly not say for sure what will happen concerning changes to service patterns, as we are only just digesting the consequences of Monday's announcement that the 'opening up' of Covid restrictions has been put back for a month, with a review in a fortnight.

Lay leaders will be working on what to do and when to do it in the churches, hoping to be able to make an announcement next week. This Sunday will be as already advertised; the following two Sundays, which would have been as the proposed pattern below or something similar after review by PCCs, are now under review again - watch this space! The issue about having two services in the morning is the time and energy required to fit two services in whilst ensuring Covid safety under the present risk assessments.

Proposed Pattern (may not now come into being on June 27th)

While further local consultation takes place on future worship patterns in 'normal' times, and if government guidelines permit, the following interim pattern is suggested, pending new plans to be implemented in the Autumn. These will of course again have to depend on national guidelines and Covid safety.
