Leading our Churches

Gamlingay PCC met to plan ahead for Gamlingay Parish last week and Everton met this week. Both parishes have identified ways to share responsibility for work among PCC members, especially when there are no Church Wardens. Conscious decisions have been made by both PCCs to share planning and decisions beyond the immediate membership. PCC members have taken lead responsibility for ensuring that decisions which have to be made by the PCC are negotiated in as timely and permission-giving a manner as possible. More on this to follow - the areas identified for work are:

- Worship, pastoral and teaching
- Communications and events
- Fabric of churches, churchyards and any other associated buildings.

Where Church Wardens would have been contacted in the past, Hilary and PCC secretaries are the links who will distribute as necessary.

This week Passiontide begins - liturgical colour goes from purple to red, as Lent focus turns towards Holy Week that begins the Sunday after this.

Suggestions for what could be improved, together with how that can be achieved with present or possible future resources, would be particularly welcome as we seek to discern God's provision in challenging times.
