## **Events Planning**

Thank you again and well done to the people who are leading and assisting with this process. Watch this space for more details next week for the opening of Gamlingay Church and the Jubilee celebrations.

The Deanery Planning Group has met this last week and is designing an enquiry document aimed at PCCs to help them reflect and feed back on key elements of church life, now and into the future. Returns are required by the end of the month.

A worship questionnaire for community consultation, and another on buildings, is under preparation to follow on from the overall enquiry document. The Benefice group that was planned some time ago to achieve much the same thing on worship within the Benefice, will benefit from this work as it approaches our wider community in the next couple of weeks. This will require everyone in the churches of the Benefice to help by approaching friends and neighbours, so that we listen to all, both within and beyond the immediate church family.

## **Opening of Gamlingay Church**

There is still no clear information, at time of writing, on the re-opening of Gamlingay Church building. I have been communicating with the Architect and Builders and hope to have an answer later this coming week. From the best information available at the moment the planned celebration on 21st May can still take place, but the building work will not be all complete. We are waiting to learn when the builder's clean will have taken place to allow our follow-up which will make the building ready to use again.

## Please Continue to Pray...

....for our PCCs as they share a meeting on Monday. The main items for discussion and action are the wider Deanery planning and our own compliance with safeguarding requirements - expanded considerably in recent times in response to past failures.

When someone asked him why he decided to become a monk his response was this : "Some people want a good job with lots of money, some people want to own a house and some people want to have children and many people want all of them. I just want to spend my time with God". It was the most beautiful, peaceful place and I went to the Pilgrims Mass in the evening . It was well worth doing a detour of an extra 8.5k to visit - the only problem was my accommodation that evening was in an Albergue



directly opposite called Tras de Convento. In my ignorance I thought it may be a convent connected to the monastery but sadly not, there was a Karaoke in the bar downstairs with all the local Spanish people performing which went on until 1am - not much sleep that night ! Such is life !
