There was a goodly gathering of people from quite a wide geographical surrounding area, and the information given was very much appreciated. Many of those present signed up as Dementia Friends, (wearing a forget-menot badge) committed to working to dispel myths and stigma associated with

this increasingly common condition, which is not by any means confined to the very elderly.

There were important core messages passed on helping to improve understanding. For instance, that Dementia is not a normal part of ageing, nor a single illness.
