Gamlingay Church Practice

At Gamlingay our worship has not returned to its pre-Covid pattern which involved more people. This has been partly because of retaining practices developed for health reasons but also lack of personnel. We are now in a position to think about a restart with servers and acolytes in the Autumn – provided there are people who would like to see this happenh and to take part in this way.

Please let Hilary or Valerie know if you would be willing to return to taking part or would like to learn what is required. It would also be good to hear any strong views for or against presenting our Eucharist in this way. Be aware we can only do that for which we have sufficient personnel.

We will look at ordering our worship to include entry and exit processions with candles, a Gospel procession and having people to help in laying out communion vessels and assisting with communion. Training and explanation will be given if there are volunteers willing and able to take part and if this is something a majority find assists in their worship.



Gamlingay and Everton – shared Communion cup?

Some churches are returning to use of a shared communion cup. In our parishes we have continued to use intinction (the priest dips the wafer in the wine) which reduces the risk of transferring infection between people using the chalice. If you have strong views on this either way, please share them with Hilary, ideally by email to help keep track of comments.
