St. Mary's Churchyard, Gamlingay - Re-wilding Project

Following a request from the Parochial Church Council (PCC) that proposed a change to the regular glass cutting routine, this was discussed by the Parish Council Meeting on 28th March. I am pleased to report that the requested changes were approved. Currently this will be an informal arrangement with the grass cutting contractors. The project will be reviewed by the PC in the autumn of 2023 and, if deemed successful, the cutting programme will be formalised for 2024/5.

It is proposed that the north and west grassed areas will be left uncut until the end of May. The area to the south of the church will not be cut again until the end of August. The informal (non-gravelled) paths between the four entrance gates will continue to be cut as usual, as will an area to the east of the church where our summer fete will be held.

It is hoped that these changes will help to encourage nature to thrive in the churchyard. It is important to note that these are **managed** changes and that we are not abandoning the areas that will not be mowed regularly.

The management required will be:

- Raking up the grass after the May cut (north and west areas)
- Raking up the grass after the August cut (south area)
- Regular inspection of the area around the old beech tree and clearing any invasive vegetation, e.g., brambles etc.
- Clear the area under the yew tree.
