Hatley Parish Council has one vacant seat resulting from the resignation of Cllr Carole Cooper in January 2024 and is seeking to co-opt a new Parish Councillor. The post is unpaid and the term of office will run until the next ordinary election in May 2026. As a Parish Councillor you would be expected to attend Parish Council meetings that are held at least five times a year. To be considered for the vacancy you must be:

- aged 18 or over
- an elector
- a resident or worker based within three miles of the Parish during the past year

Applications will be formally received and considered by the Parish Council at the Annual General Meeting due to be held on **Tuesday 21st May 2024**.
