#### Aerodrome Management

Report by Mark Jefferies Sorry for my absence in November. The absence was due to being in China with my team the Global Stars performing at 2 different venues, Nanchang and Zhuhai. This follows 2 events in Nigeria where the Nigerian air force collected the aircraft from Cambridge airport with Hercules C130 transporter. The event was to commemorate "air force day" the 59<sup>th</sup> and the inauguration of new and re-elected members of parliament.

This year the team has flown in The Australian National Airshow, India and Philippines with another Philippines show 3-5<sup>th</sup> May. Bahrain and China are booked for later in the year with possibly India again in July.

Practice and perseverance pay off with the UK team being invited to fly overseas representing the UK by many countries.

2023 was a successful year for the airfield. No issues in the management, no accidents. The fund raising air show donated  $\pounds 20,000$  to children in need with a further  $\pounds 5000$  allocated to local schools groups and kids activities.

At this time we invite local schools to apply for funding for specific projects. Great Gransden pre school has benefited the last 2 years, last year with tricycles and this year with a wooden building block set. Eltisley has an application in currently.

This years aerobatic contest will be held on the 29th June.

This years charity fund raiser will be on the 25th August.

We are seeking registered charity status at present, this will help us raise further funds.

The constant wet weather in November to date have put severe restrictions on when we can fly.

The airfield is now drying out and asable by most aircraft. If the wind drops !
