



The Gamlingay Food Project is a partnership between two Gamlingay churches – St Mary's and Gamlingay Baptist – with The Need Project and many other local and national organisations. Currently we support around 32 families on a regular basis.

We are based in the **Alms House Chapel** (opposite the Pharmacy) in Gamlingay – along with the **Community Fridge**, a partnership with shops like M&S and the Co-Op.

We always welcome donations of food items – canned fruit and vegetables, soup, pasta sauce and hot and cold meats as well as pasta, beans, biscuits, cereals, canned fish and condiments etc.
