From Hilary:

Passiontide began last Sunday as the Gospel told of Mary's extravagant gesture, anointing Jesus with costly perfume a few days before the events which we celebrate as from this coming Palm Sunday. The first service, at Everton, will remember the triumphant entry of Jesus to Jerusalem. Both Palm Sunday services are shared across the Benefice. As many as are able are encouraged to share cars and join in both the Liturgy of the Palms at Everton - a short celebratory service during which palm crosses are blessed and distributed remembering Jesus' final triumphal entry to Jerusalem, and then, after a journey between the churches, the Liturgy of the Passion which follows at Gamlingay. At this service Luke's passion account is read as part of the Communion service.

For those for whom attending both services is not appropriate, there will be a quiet time at Gamlingay before palm crosses are brought in from the earlier Everton service and distributed. The Liturgy of the Passion that follows will include a dramatic presentation of the Luke's telling of Jesus' last time, with different voices recounting the Gospel narrative, and even some whole congregation participation.



LENT STUDY

As Lent ends, Holy Week offers Transformation reflections in the final theme of Hope. The daytime Lent discussion group meets for the last time this year at the Rectory on Monday 14th April at 10.30am. There is no evening meeting as there is a Taizé service at that time.

NEWS FROM HATLEY

The group which takes care of St Denis Churchyard, which is formally a task group of the PCC, met at Sebastian Kindersley's home after a walk round the churchyard. Special thanks to the people who comprise this group for all their commitment to looking after this special place.

There will soon (April 28th) be a visit to assess the churchyard for the wildlife-friendly award which Gamlingay St Mary's holds at bronze level.

NEWS FROM EVERTON

The **APCM** took place in the Village Hall after last week's church service. The meeting accepted the report with the addition of a further report on the clock which was given verbally to the meeting and with much thanks for all the work it represented.

In particular, Dick Edwards was thanked for all he has been doing as he finally stands down from various responsibilities with which he has continued this last year after trying to step down previously.

The meeting reflected, with concern, on the financial challenges of this coming year, in particular with the large increase in the share above inflation. Clarification on the future will be sought by the parishes of the Benefice together.

The new PCC is the same as the 2024 PCC. Members were thanked by Hilary and the meeting for their past and continuing work. The valued support of the Diocesan Buildings group was specially acknowledged in helping to move things on this year.

The PCC continues to carry, collectively with Hilary, the work that would be done by churchwardens as there were again no nominations for this role for 2025.

A huge THANK YOU and WELL DONE to the team who have been organising these, led by Linda Bycroft with Dorothy Oglesby. These two ladies have decided the time is right for them personally to step down after many years and the group is formally disbanding, handing over to the PCC the information on how things have been done.
