From Hilary:

This newsletter comes to you, in the week Norman and I are away, with special thanks to Paul Hutchinson who will be looking after church this weekend including the Rogation time and Sunday services.



Thank you to everyone who has worked to get the envelopes out and collected in, particularly Ann in Gamlingay who made sure the Benefice took part in Christian Aid week this year. Counts will take place later when envelopes have all been gathered. The collection points are no longer operative, so late returns need to come to church or to a church member.

Marking Rogation - reminder

Saturday 24th May: There will be a short gathering service at Gamlingay church at 10.30am, an optional walk to Everton and a short ending service at 12.30pm at Everton church. Revd. Paul Hutchinson from St Neots will lead prayers and accompany walkers in Hilary's absence. The walk is via the Cinques and part of the Greensands Ridge Way from Gamlingay to Everton.

The Thornton pub in Everton is serving until 3pm on that afternoon and walkers are expected, **Saturday 31st May:** - a community-led 'Beating the Bounds' Walk for Rogation will include picnic and prayers at lunch time at Haley Wood. Those wishing to take part need to book in with Margot – see Hatley information on page three.

Ascension: Thursday 29th May: The Benefice celebration on the day itself will be at the evening service in Ely Cathedral. Lifts are available and there is a sign-up sheet in Gamlingay church, in the first instance, to express interest.

The Sunday after Ascension (Easter 7) on 1st June will remember the festival in our parish churches.

Pentecost/Whitsun: Sunday 8th June, marks the gifting of the Holy Spirit, which sent those who had witnessed the resurrection out into the world to share the good news.

Trinity Sunday: 15th June. This is also RSCM Music Sunday, which will be marked at Gamlingay in the morning service alongside Trinity Sunday.

The usual **Everton** congregation will be otherwise occupied on this day, so there will be no service there. At **Great Gransden** there is a 'Come and Sing' Evensong (see this poster) to which all are invited and to which Hilary can offer lifts.


