#### **Trinity Sunday**

This Sunday the church celebrates possibly the central doctrine of Christianity, on which our Creeds are based and over which the early church argued a great deal. We shall be thinking a bit more about this on Sunday; suffice to say it is our privilege to be called into this community of the Divine, and to know the eternal God in Jesus and in the Spirit that we celebrated last week.
